

#### FIP Conducts 44th Edition of Awards for Book Production

The 44th Annual Awards for Excellence in Book Production were hosted by the Federation of Indian Publishers on 30th September 2024 at the Claridges, New Delhi, marking another milestone in the Indian publishing industry. These prestigious awards continue to promote internationally comparable standards in book production, recognizing excellence across various aspects of publishing, including paper quality, printing, binding, and design elements like typography and layout. The FIP Annual Awards remain the only national recognition for excellence in book production in the country. This year, FIP received an overwhelming 971 entries from 86 publishers. The esteemed jury members selected 116 titles from 62 publishers for recognition. Out of these 38 titles were awarded the first prize, 44 titles received second prize and 34 titles wrre chosen for third prize.

The jury members for the selection of awards were: Mr. Susobhan Mondal, Asst. Registrar, Indian Institute of Mass Communication, Mr. Sunil Jain, former President of Delhi Printers' Association, Prof. (Dr.) Parmod Kumar, Professor, IGNOU, Ms. Komal Bajaj, Senior Manager of Production, Scholastic Asia

The award ceremony saw overwhelming participation from publishers across the country, cementing the awards' status as the premier national recognition for book production in India. The ceremony was graced by two renowned personalities:

Ms. Smriti Zubin Irani, a known Politician, former Cabinet Minister, Author and Social Innovator, presented the awards. Her presence and words added gravitas, reflecting her deep connection with the literary community.

Hon'ble Justice Ms. Hema Kohli, Former Judge of the Supreme Court of India, also presented the awards, underscoring the important role that publishing plays in shaping society and advancing



knowledge

In addition to recognizing publishers, FIP honored notable individuals with the prestigious 'Friends of Publishing' award. This award acknowledged individuals whose contributions have significantly advanced the publishing industry in India, further expanding the scope of the awards beyond just publishers. Sreenivasarao, Secretary , Sahitya Akademi, Mr. Rahul Goel, Partner at Anant Law, Ms. Kritika Sahni, an Intellectual Property Counsel who served as a panel counsel for the Government of India from 2015 to 2022.

The Outstanding Publisher Awards spanned multiple categories, honouring publishers who excelled in their respective fields. The winners are as follows: Mr.Vijay Ahuja, MD of Delhi Book Store, recipient of the Swaran Puraskar Brijbasi Art Press Ltd, awarded for Outstanding Children's Book Publisher of India CBS Publishers, recognized as the Outstanding Science, Technology & Medicine Publisher of India

'स्टार्टअप इंडिया' और 'मेक इन इंडिया' जैसी सरकारी पहल महत्वपूर्ण रही है जिनके लिए फंडिंग, मैन्टरशिप तथा सुव्यवस्थित नीतिगत ढांचे की जरूरत है। ऐसे उद्यमियों को सशक्त बनाने के लिए फिनटैक, हैल्थटैंक, ई-कॉमर्स आदि अन्य इनोवेटिव क्षेत्रों की सहायता मिल रही है। Flipkart, Zomato, Ola, Paytm जैसी कंपनियां वैश्विक मंच पर भारत की क्षमता का प्रदर्शन करने में अग्रणी हैं। भारतीय स्टार्टअप्स में निवेश बढ़ रहा है। 'Venture Capital Firms तथा 'Angel Investors' हमारे बढ़ते बाजार में प्रवेश करने को उत्सुक हैं।

जैसे-जैसे भारतीय स्टार्टअप कंपनियां नवीनीकरण लाने के साथ विभिन्न सामाजिक चुनौतियों का समाधान कर रहे हैं, वे न केवल आर्थिक एवं औद्योगिक विकास में योगदान दे



रहे हैं, बल्कि वैश्विक प्रतिस्पर्धा के बावजूद भारत में व्यापार के भविष्य को फिर से परिभाषित कर रहे हैं। इस प्रकार के विकास की यात्रा अभी शुरू हुई है और सम्भावनाएं असीमित हैं।

# **Global Summit of Print Industry**

### **Organized by DELHI PRINTERS' ASSOCIATION**

On 5th September, 2024 Delhi Printers' Association successfully organized Global Summit of Print Industry at the prestigious Constitution Club of India, New Delhi. Hon'ble . Mr. Harsh Malhotra (MoS Ministry of Road Transport & Highways and M o S - Ministry of Corporate Affairs) was the Chief Guest. Dignitaries from different countries attended the summit.

DPA President Mr. Puneet Talwar welcomed the International Guests, Keynote speakers, Moderators and guests. The event started with Mr.

Rajendrakumar Anayath giving a very informative lecture on the evolution of communication from the pre-historic times to the present day. Mr. Anayath had explained how communication transformed from making mere gestures and sound of pre-human creatures to the Artificial Intelligence. He said nobody wants to memorize things as these days all information is readily available on a mobile phones. He also said if the epic like Mahabharata was written today no one would read it and if Shakespeare was alive, he would have sold a single copy of his literature. The habits, techniques, practices and means of communication change. Mr. Anayath concluded that if those who use





technology with the understanding of modern requirements they could be successful.

As it was Teachers Day, Prof. RajendrakumarAnayath was presented with 'Print Guru' Award for educating print fraternity by DPA President, Mr. Puneet Talwar, General Secretary Mr. Sandeep Aggarwal and Mr. Naresh Khanna.

In the Panel discussion session, Mr. Tushar Dhote - an eminent print professional, Mr. Praveen Aggarwal - Incite Home Care Products Pvt. Ltd., Ludhiana, Mr. Neeraj Jain, Chair: FICCI Publishing Committee and Mr. Naresh Khanna - Editor, Indian Printer & Publisher Association of Publishers were the key speakers. Mr. Rajendrakumar Anayath, OSD, Department of Higher Education, Haryana was the moderator at the summit.

Mr. Tushar Dhote has described the necessity and element of technology in Printing by taking examples from how Drupa has changed over years. Mr. Neeraj Jain enlightened the audience with the role of publishing and how it is influenced by technology. Mr. Praveen Aggarwal, President of OPA and a packaging stalwart spoke about the importance of sustainability and its importance for survival. He said though everybody acknowledges the importance of sustainability, environment, etc. In the current Indian scenario it is not very profitable. The best example is though people are fully aware how the plastic clogs water flows but single use plastic is readily available, despite ban. The cost of recycling is much higher than buying new raw materials. He insisted all should go for environment friendly

















substance for the future generation. Mr. Naresh Khanna spoke about standardization across printing streams. He said the compliances are more important to Printers from Delhi because the authorities and their offices are in Delhi. The panelist agreed on one thing that there is change in everything and change is the only constant aspect in life. One has to adjust himself to accommodate change otherwise survival would be difficult. India is progressing towards trillion economy and it seems it will achieve the goal, so if one doesn't do it another will. The panel agreed the famous saying that "We have not inherited this earth from our forefathers; we have borrowed it from our children".

In International section of the event, Mr.Anil Kariyawasam President – Sri Lanka Association of Printers (SLAP), Mr. Ahmad Mughira Nurhani, President -Indonesia Print Media Association, Mr. Peter Deckker, IPP- Sri Lanka Association of Printers (SLAP) spoke about the condition of printing industry in their respective countries. Mr. Peter Deckker thanked Delhi Printers Association for arranging such a platform to express their views. He said he knew many prominent personalities in the audience. He mentioned that Prof. Anayath had taken initiative to start teaching printing in Sri Lanka. Mr. Deckker requested the help from India to share its expertise and boost his country's printing production by investing in machinery. Similar views were expressed by Mr. Nurhani from Indonesia too. Mr. Nurhani said their country does not have many big printers, mostly small printers and sought India's help to increase the infrastructural capabilities his his country's printing sector.

Mr. Harsh Malhotra who was the Chief Guest at summit. Mr. Harsh spoke about the vision of the Government – Aatma Nirbhar Bharat, citing the example of Covid Vaccine production, Mr. Malhotra commented on the capacity and resilience of India. He hoped that soon India will achieve self-sufficiency in printing and allied machinery production. Mr. Malhotra was felicitated with memento and bouquet by the President, Secretary and Treasurer of the association. Mr. Sunil Jain the coordinator of the event gave votes of thanks.



## Technical Seminars Held by DPA at Media Expo New Delhi.



In association with Messe Frankfurt India, Delhi Printers' Association conducted the following two technical Seminars during the Media Expo-2024 held at Pragati Maidan on 13th September 2024:

#### **Future of Printing:**

Prof. Dr. Kamal Mohan Chopra stated that the situation in print world is changing fast. So, for survival, one needs to adapt to the changes happening from time to time. One should be equipped to give what the customer wants. Prof Chopra reminded that technology is also advancing at a very high speed as compared to earlier days. Everything is becoming digital these days. A printer has to decide where he wants to place himself and has to work accordingly, whether to go digital or some other mode. He predicted that printing will not stagnate but the scenario will





keep on changing.

Mr. Karan Chopra, Asst. Prof. Journalism, said these days the CO2 level is increasing all around the world. It is the duty of every individual to do something however small it is. He referred to the famous book by the well known author and motivational speaker Mr. Simon Sinek's 'start with one'. No point in waiting for a saviour to come, instead one should start acting with whatever little they can. For it one should know why he is doing it and how he can do it.

Mr. Karan Chopra praised the power of social media. He said most of us came to know about this exhibition itself through social media only.
